The House Mother's role is to look after the needs of our boarders and involves creating a welcoming environment, cleaning and liaising with agencies such as laundry and kitchen. This is a part-time appointment with hours from 2.30pm to 5pm on five days per week (some flexibility possible). There may be the possibility, for the right person, of additional supervisory work in the House.

The role requires a person who has proven ability to build positive relationships with children, is practical and well-organised, and can work independently. The possession of a driving licence is highly desirable.

The position benefits from a competitive remuneration package. All staff are expected to be completely supportive of the School's Christian tradition.
