## Comment from the Principal - 24th March 2016

Dear Parents and Carers,

The gloomy weather will not, I hope, dampen the spirits as the Easter weekend approaches. A gentle reminder that the School is closed on Good Friday and on Easter Monday so I hope you might be able to enjoy the long weekend.

#### **EASTER**

It was heartening that some of our Year 10 students volunteered to assist yesterday with the setting up of the Radio West Easter Egg Treasure Hunt. We have contributed in this way for some years now, with the students enjoying the opportunity (as well as the Maccas afterwards!).

Although today is Maundy Thursday we held our own Easter service in the School. Unfortunately we were not able to be outside as intended but we certainly appreciated the service which included an *Agape* (in the Christian Church this is a meal to commemorate the Last Supper). Sadly this was the last service to be taken by our Chaplain, the Revd. Bob Booth, who retires this weekend from his locum position here and in the Church. His time here has been too short but the impact he has made has been priceless and long-lasting: we thank him most sincerely for his fine ministry and example of the Christian life.

### **ANGLICAN PARISH FETE**

Speaking of the Christian life: as you know we are developing – as part of the education we espouse – service to both the local community and the wider world beyond. In this connection the Anglican Parish Fete takes place on Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> April from 0900-1600. The School has traditionally supported the Church by providing student helpers and we have been asked to do so again this year by providing students to help run various children's games. I have asked for volunteers from Years 7 and 8 to assist with this and I would like to seek your support: could parents encourage their children to volunteer by giving their names to their Tutor. If we get sufficient volunteers students need only give-up one hour of their time in service to our wider community; if we do not get volunteers I will need to assign times to students when they will have to attend but I am sure this will not be necessary.
