## Academic Scholarship

Esperance Anglican Community School (EACS) is pleased to offer the below scholarships which provide for the part remission of tuition fees for Years 7 to 12:

### ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP (Up to 4 Scholarships available)

Awarded to up to 4 students in 2022 to attend EACS in Year 7-12. The Academic Scholarship provides up to 100% remission of tuition fees at EACS. The remission offered is at the sole discretion of the Scholarship Committee.

#### CONDITIONS OF AWARD

These Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Executive Principal by recommendation from the Associate Principals, after a successful performance at the School's Academic Assessment day. Successful candidates must demonstrate excellent academic achievement through the completion of the GATE Assessments and through their Primary Schooling years, with the potential to make a positive and ongoing contribution to the School.

The Scholarships are awarded on the condition that the recipient will finish their secondary education at EACS. Should a Scholarship recipient leave the School prior to graduation they may be required to return the financial award of the Scholarship to the School.

The continuation of the Scholarship throughout the year is subject to the recipient making excellent academic progress, displaying conduct of the highest standard and contributing to the life of the School through positive participation in the School's academic program.

#### APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The attached application form should be completed and returned to the School together with:

- A copy of the student's latest school report;
- A recent character reference from the applicant's Teacher or equivalent;

#### **INTERVIEWS**

Shortlisted applicants will be contacted to attend an interview with the Executive Principal, or his delegate. The interview will be with the student, who should be accompanied by at least one parent. Applicants and their parents will have the opportunity to tour the School facilities and meet with other Senior School staff and student leaders.


