



What's Happening in St Joseph's Hall? 5:00pm YEAR 6 ASIA SUMMIT (students in attendance until 5:30pm)

What's Happening in Primary?

The following displays, activities and demonstrations are open from 5pm-7pm:

CLASSROOM DISPLAYS (Kindy to Year 5)

We have opened up our ELC and Primary classrooms for parents and visitors to explore! Take a look at what each year group and class have been learning about and working on so far this year.

Please note: our Year 6 classrooms will be closed, but you'll find some amazing examples of their project work in the Year 6 Asia Summit, on display in St Joseph's Hall.

PRIMARY LIBRARY (centre of our Primary campus)

Our Primary Library facilities are on display - open before school and during lunch time throughout the term, this is a fantastic place for students to read and relax, or simply engage in quiet, meditative play. Students can participate in puzzles and board games here, too.

This year's Scholastic Book Fair is currently on display in the Primary Library.

PRIMARY SCIENCE (Secondary campus, closest to the Gymnasium)

Our Specialist Primary Science Room is located within reach of our other science labs, maximising access to all those resources that make 'doing science' FUN! Take a look at our facilities and enjoy some amazing demonstrations and experiments.

PRIMARY ART (Secondary campus, across the courtyard from our Art/Maths Block) Our Specialist Primary Art Room has access to all our amazing Visual Arts resources, including firing kiln, spray booths, and beautiful courtyard space. Explore our facilities, speak with our passionate teachers, and see some amazingly creative student work on display.

PRIMARY MUSIC (Secondary campus, near the Gymnasium)

Our Specialist Primary Music Room is jam packed with incredible music resources and surrounded by plenty of breakout space for students to practice. Check out the space and witness our Primary Choir in rehearsals.

Upstairs in our Gymnasium

Take a look at some of these amazing purpose-built facilities for Physical Education, Dance and Drama:

PHYS ED GENERAL CLASSROOM (PEG upstairs in the Gym)

Here you'll find information about our Outdoor Education classes in Middle School, as well as the General and Certificate courses offered for Senior School. You'll also find details of First Aid courses completed by Senior School students as part of their courses in Physical Education, as well as in Manufacturing Industry Studies and Hospitality.

WEIGHTS ROOM (upstairs in the GYM)

Senior students in Physical Education and Recreation Studies make use of these purpose-built weights and assessment rooms for classwork, and can also apply for limited before and after school access for their personal fitness needs.

DANCE STUDIO

(upstairs in the GYM, down corridor to the left) Purpose-built Dance studio with sprung floor, exercise bars and full-size mirror wall. Watch performance videos and check out other displays showcasing our students' work in Dance, offered from Year 7 and up to Year 12.

DRAMA ROOMS

(upstairs in the GYM, down corridor to the left) Wander through our Drama spaces, which also double as green rooms for production. Explore the range of theatre styles we cover, and speak with our Head of Arts about the Drama and other Arts programs at the College.

Located at the front of the College, drop in and enjoy some delicious sweet treats in our excellent Food Technology facilities, while you browse photoboards that showcase our students' creative culinary efforts. You can also puchase barista-made coffees or hot chocolates, prepared here by Year 12 Hospitality students.

What's Happening in the Arts/Maths Block?

The following Learning Area displays, activities and demonstrations are open from 5pm-7pm:

SERVICE LEARNING (ground floor, Foyer Area)

Here you'll find information about our Christian Service Learning Program, and how it builds on Gospel values and Mary MacKillop's example and ideal to 'never see a need without doing something about it', exploring areas where an individual's skills and unique talents can contribute to their expanding world.



VISUAL ARTS (ground floor, Rooms A1/A2)

Check out our purpose-built Visual Arts facilities, including firing kiln, spray booths and beautiful courtyard spaces. View student work on display, and watch the creativity of some of our budding young artists in action, as they work on their projects.

LANGUAGES (ITALIAN)

(ground floor, Room A7)

Explore the benefits of studying Italian - chat with our ATAR students and teaching team. Learn about our exciting Exchange Program in a slideshow from past participants, and meet our visiting exchange students from Italy! Enjoy Italian music, learn to introduce yourself in Italian, test your knowledge with our fun quiz, and receive a raffle entry when you stop by and talk to our team.

MATHEMATICS (upstairs, Rooms A5/A6) Take a closer look at our Mathematics department! Participate in fun challenges and thoughtprovoking interactive displays, encouraging students and parents alike to think about Mathematics at a deeper level. Learn how to best use the Mathspace program for homework and revision. Members of our Mathematics teaching team are available throughout the evening to field any questions about our teaching & learning programs, pathways to Senior School, types of assessments, and more.





What's Happening in other Learning Areas?

These LEARNING AREAS can be found in yellow on map

Wander through our learning areas, from the Library and Science labs to general classrooms, and get a feel for what it's like in Secondary at St Mary MacKillop College.

SECONDARY LIBRARY (centre of our Secondary campus)

Explore how our easy-to-access Library Portal can help students both at school AND at home with their research and assignments through access to Resource Guides, ClickView, Wheeler and more. Our actual Library space is designed to encourage our students to relax, read, study and quietly play, with puzzles, UNO and more available during lunchtimes. We have a Book Club for students to participate in, and our online Portal also provides a wealth of resources to inspire and develop a genuine love of reading.

SCIENCE LABORATORIES (Rooms SC5/SC6)

Members of the Science Department will be happy to give you a tour of our fantastic Science facilities. Enjoy our demonstrations and have fun participating in experiments (like making fireworks!). There will also be intriguing student investigations, posters and models on display.

ENGLISH (Rooms 13/14)

Delve into text analysis and creative work our students have produced in their English classes. Explore other examples of student work in assessment folders, imaginative writing and visual creations. Listen and view innovative presentations on texts and concepts covered in class. Challenge yourself be as creative as our students and write your own six-word memoir!

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Gain an insight into what Religious Education at MacKillop REALLY involves, and why it's valuable for all our students. Explore creative student work from lessons in social justice, church history, the Bible, sacraments, significant people, saints and more. Teachers will be available on the evening to further discuss our programs across Years 7-12.

HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES (HaSS) (Rooms 20/21)

From ancient Rome to the current political and economic climate, see what students have been learning across the department of humanities and social sciences. Check out our displays of student project work, watch a mock courtroom trial in action, and cast your vote on some community issues.

What's Happening in our Design & Technology Centre?

Located at the far end of the Secondary campus, our purpose-built Design and Technology Centre boasts state-of-art equipment and facilities, enabling students to safely develop high level skills and experience across a range of **Wood, Metal, Jewellery, and Systems Engineering Technologies**. This evening, you'll be able to participate in workshop activities, view a variety of student projects on display, and watch demonstrations across all mediums.



What's Happening in our Music/Media Block?

Take a walk through our amazing Music and Media facilities, featuring a covered Rectango space for informal lunchtime concerts, as well as green-screen, sound recording, photography and film studio facilities.

PHOTOGRAPHY (Room M3)

Check out a 'special effect' photography session in action, set up in our resourceful Photography classroom.

MUSIC RECORDING & PERFORMANCE


(Rooms M2/M4) Wander through and observe our music performance and sound tech students in action, making creative use of the state-of-the-art facilities and equipment available.
