A Defensive Approach to Ransomware

Ransomware, a form of malware, ruthlessly holds a computer's data for ransom via encryption. If the user doesn't pay the cybercriminal a certain amount of money within a certain amount of time, their data will be lost forever.

The recent "WannaCry" ransomware attack was a worldwide cyberattack which targeted computers running the Microsoft Windows

operating system by encrypting data and demanding ransom payments in the Bitcoin cryptocurrency. If the user does not pay \$300 ransom within three days, the amount is doubled. If payment is



not made within a week, the files are deleted.

Security researchers caught on to the threat quickly and have made attempts to curb its infection rate. Unfortunately, this malware not only spreads itself rapidly, it also evolves quickly to avoid any attempts at mitigation. According to Europol, the European Union's law enforcement agency, in just the short time since WannaCry was first discovered, the

outbreak has increased to more than 200,000 users in 150 countries.

This ransomware threat is still very active on the internet, and you should take immediate care in order to not become one of its victims. Be sure you are using and updating security software in order to stay protected from the latest discovered versions of this ransomware. Patches have already been released by Microsoft, including patches for previously unsupported operating systems (XP, 2K3, Windows 8).

Additionally, once you are sure your computer is clear of infection, perform a backup of your hard drive. After you have completed the backup, be sure you have unplugged your hard drive from the machine for safe storage.

For more long-term prevention of ransomware attacks, follow these ransomware tips for businesses and consumers:

1. New ransomware variants appear on a regular basis. Always keep your security software up to date to protect yourself.



- Keep your operating system and other software updated. Software updates will frequently include patches for newly discovered security vulnerabilities that could be exploited by ransomware attackers.
- Email is one of the main infection methods. Be wary of unexpected emails, especially if they contain links and/or attachments.
- 4. Be especially wary of any Microsoft
 Office email attachment that advises
 you to enable macros to view its content. Unless you are absolutely sure
 that this is a genuine email from a
 trusted source, do not enable macros and,
 instead, immediately delete the email.
- 5. Backing up important data is the single most effective way of combating a ransomware infection. Attackers have leverage over their victims by encrypting valuable files and leaving them inaccessible. If the victim has backup copies, they can restore their files once the infection has been cleaned up. However, organizations should ensure that backups are

appropriately protected or stored offline so that attackers can't delete them.

 Using cloud services could help mitigate a ransomware infection, since many retain previous versions of files, allowing you to "roll back" to the unencrypted form.

Ransomware is an online form of the bullying. Here, the bully gets on your computer and takes your personal files: documents,

photos, financial information, all the things you care about. Those files are still on your computer, dangling in front of you, but they are encrypted now, useless to you. In order to get them unencrypted, you'll need to pay. Growing 4500% since 2014, this is the

Quick Tech Productivity Pointers

Adding Fonts to Mac and Windows

The Mac operating system includes a utility called Font Book that you can use to add, remove and organize the fonts on your computer. You can find the program in your Mac's Applications folder.

After you download a new typeface from an online font shop, double-click the file you received. Font Book should open automatically and display a sample alphabet or character set in the new font. Click the Install Font button at the bottom of the box to add the font to your Mac's type library.

Font Book checks the fonts it installs to make sure there are no incompatibilities with the new files. The program should also alert you if it finds duplicate fonts on the computer. If you want Font Book to remove a font you no longer use, click All Fonts on the left side of the window and

select the name of the typeface in the Fonts list. Go to the File menu and choose the Remove option; fonts used by the macOS menus, dialogue boxes and other system functions cannot be removed.

Windows users can install a new font by rightclicking the downloaded file and selecting Install

from the menu, or by double-clicking the font file and selecting the Install button. Fonts can be managed in the Windows Font control panel. To get there from the desktop, go to the Start menu, type "fonts" in the search box and select "Fonts — Control Panel" from the results

lists. When the control panel is open, you can add fonts by dragging them into the window. Selecting a font in the window and clicking the Delete button removes it.
