- Father's Day is celebrated annually on December 5, which was the day King Bhumibol (Rama IX) was born.
- Phuttaraksa (the canna flower) is the symbol of Father's Day.

Constitution Day

- This Thai national holiday is held annually on December 10th.
- The day commemorates Thailand's 1932 adoption of a constitutional monarchy.
- Thailand has had 20 charters, the most recent constitution having been adopted in 2017.
- The Democracy Monument is located on Ratchadamnoen Avenue in Bangkok.
