CARES Act – Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF)

Student Portion

Del-Mar-Va Beauty Academy has signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification And Agreement for the HEERF grant. The grant will be received in two parts, the first half (\$54,423.00) will be distributed to Title IV eligible students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

The student portion of the Higher Education Emergency Relief fund was received by the institution on 8/3/2020. The number of students receiving the HEERF grant is 34. The grant was divided equally to Title IV eligible students in attendance during the COVID-19 shut-down (each student will receive \$1600.00 to \$1601.00) Five students either returned or failed to claim their disbursement as of December 31, 2020 resulting in \$8,004.00 in funds to be distributed to students requesting help due to Covid 19.

During the period January 1, 2021 to March 31, 2021, \$1,000.00 was distributed to students who demonstrated exceptional need due to the Corona virus pandemic. The remaining balance in the HEERF 1 fund was \$7,004.00 as of March 31, 2021.

The grant is intended to assist students with expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to corona virus (including eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance such as food, housing, tuition, course materials, technology, health care, and child care). We instruct the students to use these funds for this purpose.
