Covid-19 Relief Funds for Students funded by CRRSAA section 314(a)(4)

June 30, 2021

In order to ensure an equitable distribution of HEERF II funds to students with financial need, the institution has developed the following procedure:

- Students will be required to request a disbursement in writing. A form has been developed to
  provide the required information. Students should see the Director to obtain and submit the
  form. Students must be enrolled to submit a request.
- 2. Requests will be reviewed by the administration to determine the award amount based on exceptional need. The determination will be made on a case-by-case basis.
- 3. Administration has estimated individual awards to be between \$500 and \$2000.

The total HEERF II amount provided to the school is \$61,025.00.

There are currently 30 (Title IV) eligible students.

The school has one year to distribute the funds. The award amounts may change as the year progresses depending on the number of requests received and funds available. Student awards may be distributed in installments depending on the individual circumstance, this will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

- 4. Funds distributed to students under section 314 (c)(4) of the CRRSAA may be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or child care.
- 5. Awarding will end when the funds are exhausted but no later than March 31, 2022.

As of June 30, 2021, a total of \$ 10,000.00 has been distributed to students.
