Covid-19 Relief Funds for Students

Authority PL 116-260 III Coronavirus Response And Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA)

- Del-Mar-Va Beauty Academy has signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and assures that it will distribute funds received under CRRSAA as financial aid grants prioritizing students with exceptional need. Funds distributed to students under this authority may be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or child care.
- 2. The total amount of the grant awarded and potentially available to the school is \$96,557.00.
- 3. As of March 31, 2022, a total of \$ 45,750.00 of this grant award has been distributed to students.
- 4. As of March 31, 2022, there are forty students eligible to receive the grant.
- 5. As of March 31, 2022 twenty-six students have received financial aid grants from CRRSAA.
- 6. In order to ensure an equitable distribution of awarded funds to students with financial need, the institution has developed the following procedure:
  - a. Students will be required to request a disbursement in writing. A form has been developed to provide the required information. Students should see the Director to obtain and submit the form. Students enrolled during the official state of emergency who have been impacted by the Coronavirus Pandemic are eligible to submit an application.
  - b. Requests will be reviewed by the administration to determine the award amount based on exceptional need. The determination will be made on a case-by-case basis.
  - c. Administration has estimated individual awards to be between \$500 and \$3,000.

The school has one year to distribute the funds. The award amounts may change as the year progresses depending on the number of requests received and funds available. Student awards may be distributed in installments depending on the individual circumstance, this will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

Awarding will end when the funds are exhausted but no later than August 19, 2022.
