SOPs From The Trenches Trending This Month... IMAGE TREND® with ADOBE®

Most programs require the use of additional plugins or applications in order for them to function to their complete capability. **Image Trend Software** has these symbiotic partnerships; today we will focus on **Adobe**.

There are various requirements that must be met in order for **Image Trend** to perform with full functionality. The main problem we run into is that one or both components of **Adobe** are missing and leaves the user scratching their head at the most critical time. More explicitly, you cannot see images, videos, graphics or presentations on the fly.

Adobe Reader and Adobe Flash Player must be installed for things like the Interactive Assessment to work. So if you're getting any error messages or blank screens... check to make sure you have Adobe Flash Player and Adobe Reader installed. If they are not, call your

IT MSP Class Computing at (312) 262-3930.

Further, it is not good enough to just install the software. Once installed, you should power the device down, bring it back up and then start the **Adobe** programs up on the first boot after install. Then you start-up **Image Trend Software**. On subsequent uses, you don't need to start **Adobe** first, **Image Trend** will initiate that by itself.

Why is this happening to begin with? Probably due to an upgrade or someone deleted **Adobe Reader** or **Flash** by accident, or they never were on the machine to begin with if it is new.

Now that you read this article go and check your devices. If you have this issue, give us a call immediately. I doubt any of our customers will have this issue, unless someone deleted the programs by mistake.

PDF FORMATTING ISSUES are no new completed

If you notice formatting issues when creating a PDF file of an FH report, switch to a third-party PDF print driver such as Adobe Acrobat or Cute PDF.

- 1. In FH, from the **Reports** menu, choose the type of report you want to print to a PDF file.
- 2. In the **Reports** dialog box that appears, select the specific report you want to create, then click **Run**.
- 3. In the **Output Report To** dialog box that appears, click **Select Printer**.
- 4. In the **Printer** dialog box that appears, from **Name**, choose the third-party PDF printer driver you want to use, and then click **OK**.
- 5. In the **Output Report To** dialog box, click **OK**.

Proceed as normal with specifying the report's query parameters and generating the report.

EXPORTING NFIRSS

When exporting NFIRS incident data to a transaction file for the state, many customers are confused when a message appears stating that there are no new completed incidents for the specified date range, even though there are incidents in the database for that date range. This happens because the items were exported in an earlier transaction file, and as a result, are being ignored for the current export.

To prevent this message, in the NFIRS 5.0 Export Wizard, on the second screen, be sure to select Export all records in this range as new transactions even if previously exported.

WHEN USING FH INSPECTOR, WHY ISN'T THE INSPECTION I CREATED IN FH SHOWING UP ON MY IPAD?

The inspection in FH may not have a unit assigned to it, which is why the inspection is not synchronizing as expected.

- 1. In FH, in the Occupancy module, open the occupancy record containing the inspection that is synchronizing to the iPad.
- 2. On the Address tab, enter a unit

lookup code in the **Unit** field, and then click **Save**.

- 3. Run the FH Cloud Synchronization Utility as normal to "push" the updated inspection up to the FH Cloud as normal.
- 4. On the iPad, synchronize FH Inspector with the FH Cloud as normal to "pull" the updated inspection from the FH Cloud down to FH Inspector on the iPad.

Verify that the inspection appears in FH Inspector.

NOT READY FOR 10?

Microsoft has released Windows 10 and, for users with Windows 7 or 8, it's available for the low, low cost of free. Sounds like a sweet deal. But, maybe you're not ready for the jump guite yet. Maybe, you depend on software built for older platforms or just want to give them some time to work out any enviable bugs that naturally arise. Whatever your reasons for holding off, Windows still loves to remind you anytime you start up your computer or Internet Explorer that your upgrade is waiting. It nags and nags and nags, until you ignore it long enough and it starts to install itself. You might wake up in the morning to find your whole layout is different. It can be very evasive in the way it installs without your knowledge and, even though it's possible to roll back to your previous version, it's still buggy and time consuming.

So, how can all this be avoided? Microsoft has made a few different ways to keep that reminder in your face in the form of updates and changed to your registry. Luckily, there are two very helpful (and free) apps available to help you deal with all of them. The first app is **Never 10**

Never 10 is super easy. Just one button takes care of everything: the update files, the registry keys, even the 6 GB worth of installation files you didn't know downloaded to your computer. If you ever change your mind, just load the app again and the same button can reverse the whole process.

While **Never 10** is a great "one shot, one kill" solution, some might want a few more options. Perhaps, you're not ready to upgrade quite yet, but don't want to have to re-download the pre-mentioned 6 GB. Then try out **GWX Control Panel** <u>http://ultimateoutsider.com/downloads/</u> is available as an install file or as a more portable application file to keep on a flash drive and lets you disable or enable certain aspects of the Windows 10 nagging. It also provides handy information of any traces of the upgrade still lurking on your system.

Windows 10 has premiered with many mixed reviews so far, with most of the negative feedback stemming from the forced, secretive installs. However, there is no reason to pull the trigger until you're ready. These 2 apps will help you stay in familiar territory until you're ready to make the big jump forward.

Microsoft.com has confirmed the Windows 10 free upgrade offer ends July 29, 2016. Our official policy is to run the software that came installed on your computer; <u>Unless</u> it was purchased in the last 6 months and there is a Windows 10 feature that will provide ROI. Maybe it is time for a new computer... Call to see what deals Lenovo, HP, Microsoft or Toughbook has to offer. **Toughpads** are selling well too; high-end, but sweet.
