# Kennedy and our International Mission Commitment

Kennedy Baptist College is partnering with Transform Cambodia as our first international mission commitment to help rescue children from poverty in the developing world. The Kennedy Centre opened in October 2017 with seven staff members and 103 children who attend daily and receive intensive English tuition, healthcare and learn valuable leadership skills to help them become change makers for their nation in whatever capacity they choose. The Centre is dependent on the ability of the Kennedy Community to sponsor the 103 children attending. (No funding from College income acquired through tuition fees or government grants can be used for this project.)
