

Novel Coronavirus – COVID-19 Update: 11

Dear Parents/Guardians

This update is to further clarify the position of Kennedy Baptist College for the commencement of Term 2.

- 1. The College will open for students on Wednesday 29 April as communicated in our last update on 8 April.
- 2. We support the Minister for Education's view that the classroom is still the best place for all students to learn but acknowledge that parents/carers can still choose to keep their child/ren at home.
- 3. Year 11 and 12 students are strongly encouraged to attend school and normal classes.
- 4. The off-campus learning presented at the end of Term 1 continues to be refined. The lessons will be a combination of live Microsoft Teams meetings and some video lessons.

To ensure the health and safety of all members of the College community we will ensure the following:

- 1. All students will be encouraged to maintain the 1.5m social distancing protocols as outlined by the Health Department.
- 2. Increased environmental cleaning will be conducted throughout the day including high touch surfaces and toilet blocks. Additional hygiene measures including hand sanitizer will be available in all classrooms.
- 3. Currently no assemblies or excursions are planned for the near future.
- 4. Parents and visitors are encouraged to remain in their vehicles when dropping off or picking up their child/ren. We would encourage you to call the College first if you need to visit the Uniform Shop.
