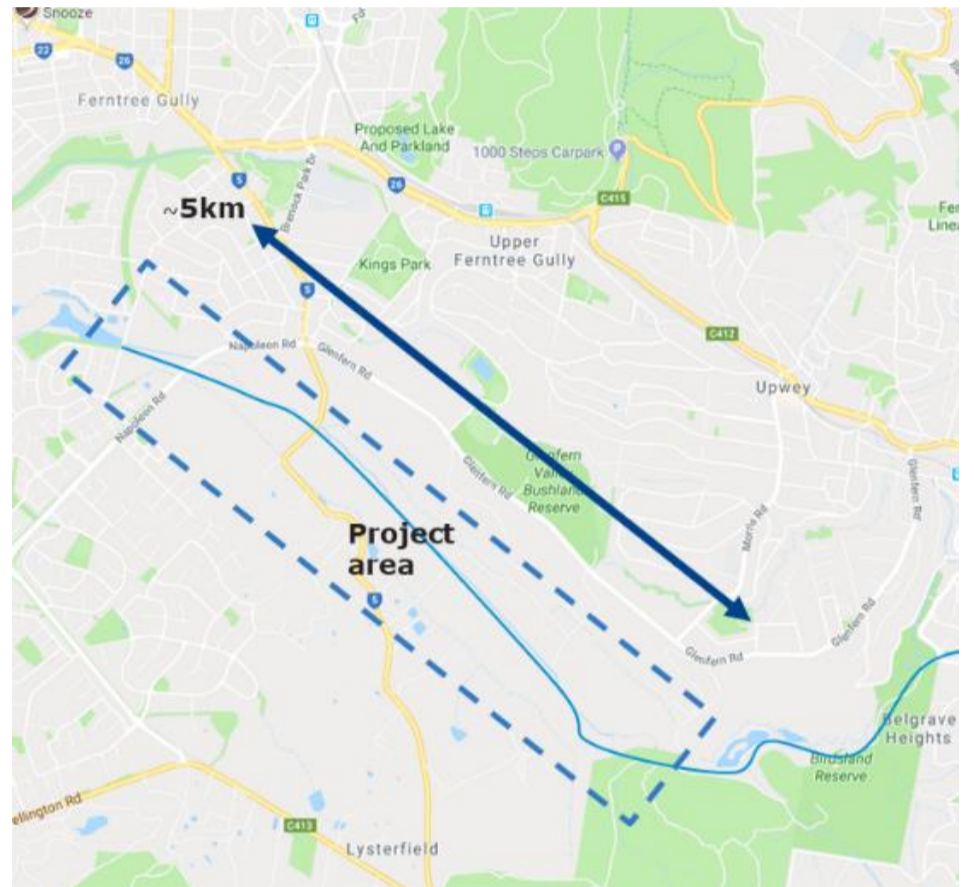


The future of Monbulk Creek

The platypus population within the Dandenong catchment has significantly declined to a critical level with only one population remaining in Monbulk Creek. The population is heading toward localised extinction due to lack of habitat and low genetic diversity.
