





Guidance	Actions to mitigate the introduction and spread of COVID-19
	<p><b>Students must stay home if they are unwell</b> or if they have or anyone at home has the following symptoms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Fever or flu-like symptoms, such as coughing, sore throat and fatigue</li> <li>○ Shortness of breath</li> <li>○ They have, or anyone at home has been in close contact with someone who has returned from overseas in the last 14 days</li> <li>○ They have or anyone at home has been in close contact with someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19</li> </ul> <p>Students who have travelled interstate must comply with the Victorian Government travel advice. Staff &amp; students are reminded to remain hyper-vigilant in maintaining good personal hygiene.</p>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If upon arrival a student exhibits COVID-19 Symptoms, they will be immediately isolated.</li> <li>• Parents/Guardians will be contacted to collect their daughter. The student will be encouraged to self-isolate until they can be tested and receive the results.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Daily cleaning contractor arrangements are to include performing a thorough clean of all buildings' surfaces using a hospital grade disinfectant.</li> <li>• An adequate supply of liquid soap, paper towel and disinfectant will be available</li> <li>• All desks are to be wiped down with disinfectant at the start of class and paper towels to be disposed of in bins in classrooms.</li> <li>• Students will be reminded to carefully place all paper towels and disposable PPE in bins for cleaners to collect.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Information will continue to be provided to students on washing hands or using hand sanitizer before and after moving between rooms or buildings and after touching any doors.</li> <li>Students will be reminded of ways to use good hand and cough/sneeze hygiene (Refer to posters in the toilets)</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Face masks are to be worn on public transport.</li> <li>Face masks are recommended for use when physical distancing of 1.5m cannot be maintained. A face mask must cover the nose and mouth. (Face shields, scarves or bandanas do not meet these requirements).</li> <li>Staff are allowed to remove their mask when teaching or speaking to a hearing impaired person.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All students are to use hand sanitiser when they enter the College and when they enter a new classroom or learning space.</li> <li>Hand Sanitiser will be available throughout the school.</li> <li>Supply will be checked at end of each day</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students will be encouraged to maintain physical distancing arrangements from adults on site.</li> <li>Staff and adult visitors are briefed to follow physical distancing rules, ie to remain at least 1.5 metres from other individuals wherever possible.</li> <li>Students will be encouraged to avoid shaking hands, hugging or touching others.</li> <li>Large indoor gatherings will be avoided. Where they cannot be avoided, appropriate protocols will be followed</li> <li>Lunch will be eaten outside rather than indoors if possible.</li> <li>Food or drinks will not be shared.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Parents/Guardians will be actively discouraged from entering the College during drop off/pick up times.</li> <li>Should a parent/guardian need to enter the College, she/he will be required to sign In.</li> </ul>
