



WHAT IS A TRAINEESHIP?

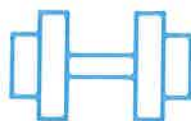

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE TRAINING PROGRAM?

- Recent high school graduates or leavers
- Young Australians – the average age of trainees is between 16 and 24 years of age
- First Nations peoples and non-First Nations peoples

TYPES OF TRAINEESHIPS & WHAT YOU'LL BE STUDYING?

FULL-TIME TRAINEESHIPS

- 12 month placement in an organisation
- Studying a Certificate III or IV
- Working 38 hours a week

PART-TIME TRAINEESHIPS

- 18 - 24 month placement in an organisation
- Studying a Certificate III or IV
- Working a minimum of 15 hours a week

SCHOOL-BASED TRAINEESHIPS

- 2 year placement in an organisation
- Studying a Certificate II or III
- Working approximately 1 day a week while completing Year 11 and 12
