

COVID-19 Vaccinations

The very latest on the vaccine

OhioHealth is distributing COVID-19 vaccines according to state and federal guidelines. **A limited number of appointments will be available each week**, due to vaccine supply. If you miss your scheduling window, new appointments will open soon.

Eligible community members can schedule an appointment through [OhioHealth MyChart](#), or by calling the **OhioHealth Vaccine Hotline at (614) 533.6999** weekdays from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.



People 80 and older can get the vaccine at OhioHealth vaccine clinics. Following state guidelines, we anticipate opening vaccine appointments to people 75 and older on January 25, 70 and older on February 1, and 65 and older on February 8. You may also receive the vaccine at retail clinics and other providers throughout Ohio.



A limited number of appointments will be available each week, due to vaccine supply. If you miss your scheduling window, new appointments will open soon. Walk-in appointments are not available at [OhioHealth vaccine clinics](#) or care sites. Physician offices cannot schedule vaccine appointments.



Scheduling through OhioHealth MyChart is recommended, as call volumes may be high. You can sign in to your MyChart account at [MyChart.OhioHealth.com](https://mychart.ohiohealth.com) or through the [OhioHealth mobile app](#). OhioHealth patients who do not have a MyChart account may [request an activation code](#). Make sure your contact information is correct. You will receive a notification when you are eligible to schedule a vaccine appointment. You can also request proxy access to a loved one's account, if you feel they may need assistance, using the [Share My Record](#) feature. **If you are not an OhioHealth patient or need scheduling support**, call (614) 533.6999 weekdays from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.



Vaccine appointments are only available at designated [OhioHealth vaccine clinics](#). At this time, we are not providing COVID-19 vaccines to the public at our hospitals, emergency departments, urgent care locations and most physician offices. When you schedule your appointment, you will select your preferred location and receive details about where to go.
