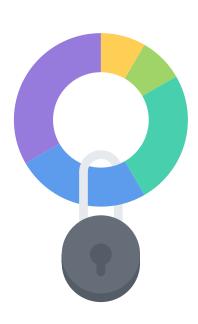
Passwords are a good place to start when implementing policies. Set rules for password length and complexity within your business.
