

NEW JERSEY NAMES NEW ACTING INSURANCE FRAUD PROSECUTOR

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On December 9, 2015, Acting Attorney General John J. Hoffman announced the appointment of Hudson County resident Christopher Lu as the state's Acting Insurance Fraud Prosecutor. Lu, a 2003 graduate of Seton Hall University School of Law, joined the Attorney General's Office in 2011, serving first as a Special Assistant and then Deputy Chief of Staff to the Attorney General. Prior to that, he served as a liaison with the governor's policy office, an Assistant Prosecutor in the Essex County Prosecutor's Office, and a law clerk to the Honorable Joseph A. Falcone, J.S.C.
