## CODE OF CONDUCT

Andrew Wommack Ministries Canada (AWMC) /Charis Bible College Toronto (CBC) is committed to reaching as far and as deep with the Gospel of God's unconditional love, and the balance of grace and faith, as possible. In our education, business, and ministry, we live according to Jesus' commandment to love one another as He has loved us proving that we are His disciples (John 13:34). As disciples of the Lord, we choose every day to "...Hate what is evil; cling to what is good...[and] to do what is right in the eyes of everyone" (Romans 12: 9-17). Therefore the standards set forth are to be guiding principles based upon the Word of God as interpreted by the AWM Canada (AWMC) Director/ Board of Directors for AWMC and Charis Bible College to help you not only represent AWMC/CBC, but the kingdom of God to yourself, coworkers, our partners, students and your community at large.

As a student of Charis Bible College, I:

- Accept that the Holy Spirit is continuing the work He started at Pentecost empowering me to live a godly life and continue in all the works of Jesus.
- Accept that all Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness.
- Accept that grace gives me the power to overcome sin, not indulge in it.
- Accept the responsibility to represent *CBC* integrity and honesty by being a positive Christian role model in judgement, dignity, respect, and Christian living. I acknowledge that this includes, but is not limited to, abstaining from activities such as the abuse of alcohol, use of illicit drugs, lying and deceptive behavior, pornography, and the use of vulgar and profane language. While non-medical use of Marijuana is now prohibited in Canada, it is considered unacceptable drug use by Charis students and its use is deemed grounds for dismissal.
- Accept that God's expectation is the unmarried shall live pure and celibate lives and the married (marriage defined as between one man by gender at birth and one woman by gender at birth) Should be faithful to their spouse. This means CBC strictly prohibits all sexual misconduct, including but not limited to, premarital, extramarital, homosexual activity, sexual harassment/violation, or the promotion thereof.
- Accept that all men are created equal and therefore this includes, but is not limited to, abstaining from activities such as physically harming others, engaging in racist conduct, or expressing racist viewpoints.
- Believe that life begins at conception, and therefore will not participate in abortions or the promotion of abortions or abortion agencies.
- Accept that as a disciple of Jesus I am to be subject to the governing authority of my country therefore, I agree to abstain from engaging in any behavior contrary to the Criminal Code/ Criminal Law of the nation except for those laws that are contrary to the Bible.
- Agree to abide by all policies and procedures applicable to me as a CBC Student established by AWM International (AWMI)/ AWMC/ CBC and World Outreach.

It should be stressed that the above statements are not intended to be all inclusive of behaviors that are inconsistent with Biblical standards. If there are violations of this Code of Conduct, we have the right to decide on the appropriate action to either be disciplinary or immediate expulsion. In deciding, we may consider: 1) The seriousness of your conduct, 2) Your student records, 3) Your ability/willingness to correct the conduct, 4) Actions we have taken for similar conduct by others, 5) How your action affects the college and other circumstances.

## **DOCTRINAL STATEMENT**

#### The Scriptures:

We believe that all of Scripture (both the Old and New Testament) is verbally inspired by God and is our final authority in all matters pertaining to doctrine, reproof, correction and instruction in righteousness (II Timothy 3:16, 17).

#### God:

We believe in only one true God; One in essence, nature, and attributes, but existing in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit (I John 5:7).

#### Jesus Christ:

We believe in the deity of the Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, of His shed blood on Calvary for the forgiveness of our sins, of His bodily resurrection and ascension to the Father's right hand. We do not believe that He is simply "a" way to the Father, but rather the only way through which we can receive righteousness, regeneration, sanctification, and glorification. He is, in fact, our salvation (I Corinthians 1:30-31).

#### Holy Spirit:

We believe in the baptism with the Holy Spirit, expressed with speaking in tongues according to Acts 1:8; 2:4; 9:17; 10:44-46; 11:15, 16; and 19:6. We believe this experience is distinct from, and subsequent to, the new birth and can be received by faith (Galatians 3:2).

#### Salvation:

We believe that all who, in repentance and faith, receive the Lord Jesus as Savior and Lord are born again (Acts 20:20-21; Romans 10:9-13).

#### Healing:

We believe that the redemptive work of Christ on the cross has provided healing for the human body (Matthew 8:16, 17; Isaiah. 53:4; 1 Peter. 2:24).

#### The Resurrection:

We believe in the resurrection of the just and the unjust; one to everlasting life and one to everlasting damnation (Matthew 25:46).

#### The Second Coming:

We believe in a literal, physical second return of the Lord Jesus Christ (1 Th 1:10; 4:16-17).

#### The Church:

We believe that the universal church is comprised of all true believers who have received salvation through Christ (Ephesians 1:22-23). We also believe in and encourage fellowship with a local church (Hebrews 10:25).

#### Gifts of the Spirit:

We believe that spiritual gifts and manifestations of the Holy Spirit are for the common good and building up of others today (1 Corinthians 12:7).

### **STATEMENT OF FAITH**

We believe the Bible is inspired and empowered by God, infallible and authoritative.

We believe in one eternal God who exists as three separate persons; the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

We believe Jesus Christ is the Son of God, born of a virgin, lived a sinless life as He walked among men, demonstrated the authority and power of God in works and speech, died on the cross, rose from the dead on the third day, and is now seated at the right hand of God having accomplished all that is necessary for man'ssalvation.
