

To access ABA services through Medicaid funding, we will need the following documents.

1. Prescription for behavior analysis services, with a specific mental health diagnosis, SIGNED by an MD/DO

2. A comprehensive diagnostic evaluation--

The diagnostic report needs to include the findings, recommendations and a diagnosis **(that matches the physician's order)**. This report must include all the pieces of an evaluation that Medicaid expects. Types of reports that will now be accepted:

- A. An evaluation by the child's school district that has determined the child is eligible for special education (psychoeducational)
- B. A diagnostic evaluation by a developmental pediatrician
- C. A diagnostic evaluation by a state licensed psychologist
- D. A diagnostic evaluation conducted by a board-certified child and adolescent psychiatrist.

3. Comprehensive Diagnostic Evaluation should include **ALL the following**:

- A. Clinical findings
- B. Diagnostic recommendations
- C. Indicate what clinical instruments were used
- D. What screening tools were used
- E. Summarize the findings and make recommendations
- F. Include the F code for the diagnosis

3. The referral and consent forms for Behavior Basics.

Once we receive all the documentation back, we can start the review and will be in contact if anything is missing.
