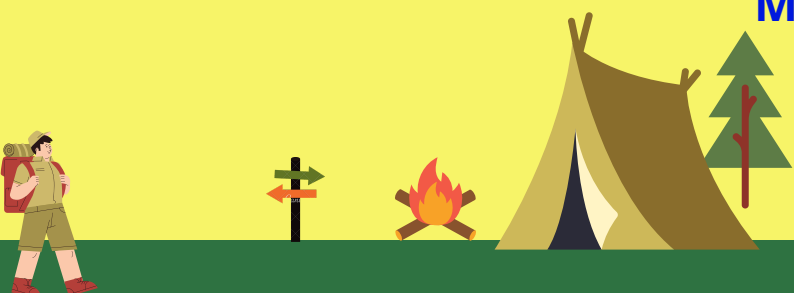
Summer Camp

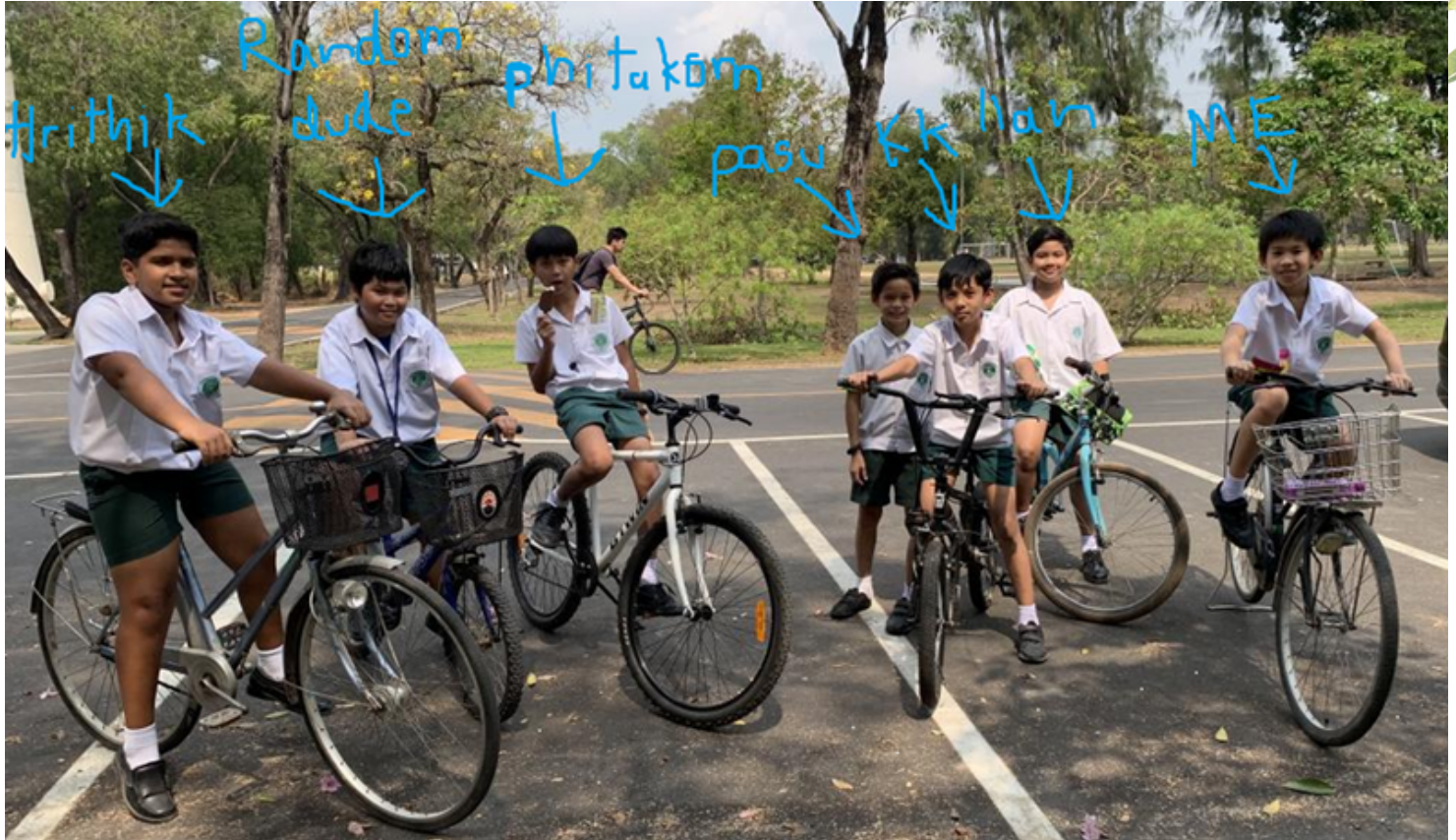
Turns out we had the same personality so we got to talk for the first time.

SUMMER SPED BULLETIN

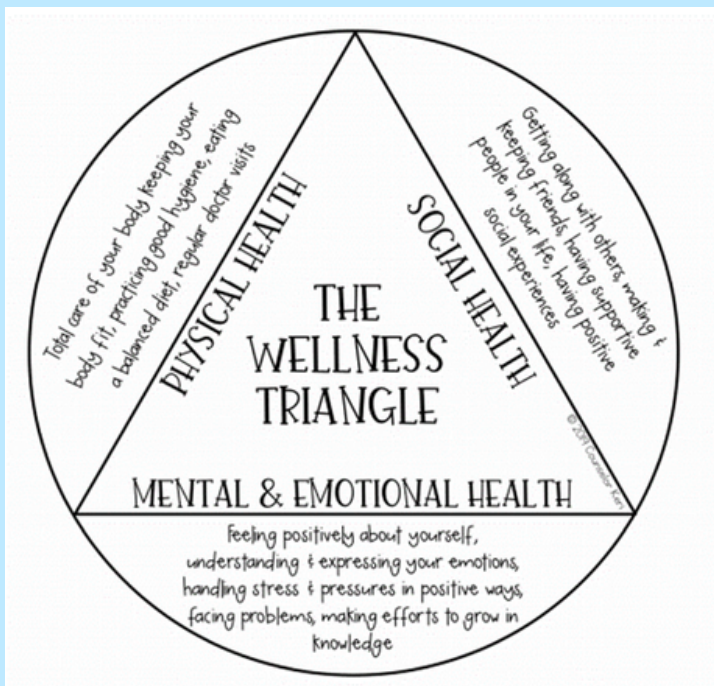
Dear AITIS Families,

Creativity: Body and Brain Workshop

The late former President of South Africa, Nelson Mandela, once said, “Education is the most powerful weapon which you can use to change the world.” True to this statement, for two long years at the height of the global pandemic, AITIS educated its learners virtually so that they could continue to inspire and encourage, and help the students navigate the unprecedented move to online learning. Along with this, the AITIS School Management Team also made sure that its teachers and staff continued to have their professional development enrichment training conducted online.



This time another workshop was conducted not online, but in person, and was held at the AIT Conference Centre on Wednesday, 29 June 2022. Once again, AITIS welcomed Mr. Danut Chantawat, casually known as Ryan, an accomplished ‘total well-being therapist,’ to share his knowledge and expertise by leading another professional development workshop for the AITIS teachers and staff. This was a follow-up workshop on understanding the different dimensions of wellness.

Indeed, “Life as a teacher begins the day you realise that you are always a learner.” This time, the workshop focused on taking time to reflect, to write and share on what is being done, experienced, felt and discovered. Mr. Ryan introduced the ‘divergent thinking tests measures,’ namely: originality and novelty (being able to generate novel and breakthrough ideas and solutions); fluency and ideation (becoming an idea generator with a higher chance of creating breakthrough ideas); flexibility and adaptability (being able to see situations from multiple perspectives); and elaboration and explanation (detail-oriented to generate intriguing plans).



All these measures were divided into four categories, namely: 1 on 1 non-stop; invisible clay; tableau vivant; and the masterpiece. These categories were tackled with fun-filled, interactive activities, for a day full of laughter and creativity amongst teachers and staff. Indeed, as was mentioned and emphasised in his first workshop, laughter and learning are vital factors to relieve stress; boost the immune system; lower blood pressure; elevate one’s mood; and reduce any form of pain, whether physical, emotional, or mental.



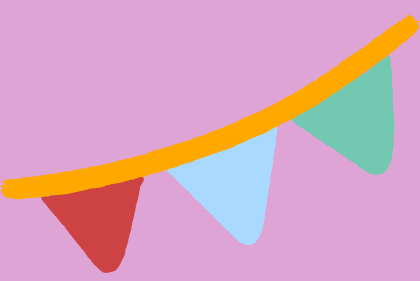
My take on this workshop is that apart from encouraging and equipping the teachers and staff to be more creative, reflective, and adapt to any given situation, it gave us the tools needed to face head-on any challenges along the way as one unit. Supporting, cooperating, and building each other up, spiced with the old cliché, 'laughter is the best medicine,' will enable AITIS to move forward against all odds.

Let me reiterate an anonymous inspirational quote which says, “Teachers encourage minds to THINK, hands to CREATE and hearts to LOVE.”

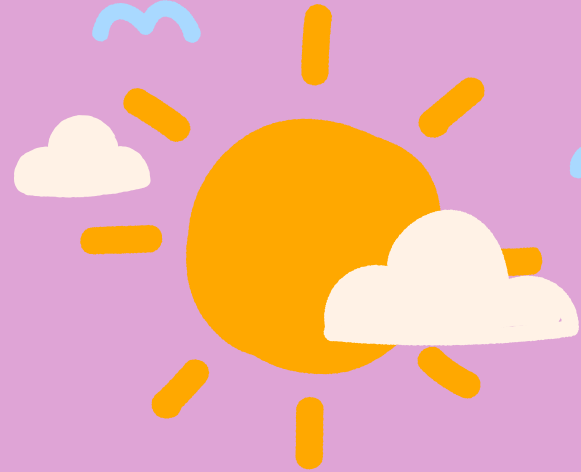


Again, what better way for the AITIS teachers and staff to end the school year 2020-21 with a seamless, productive, and enriching workshop coated with much laughter and fun.

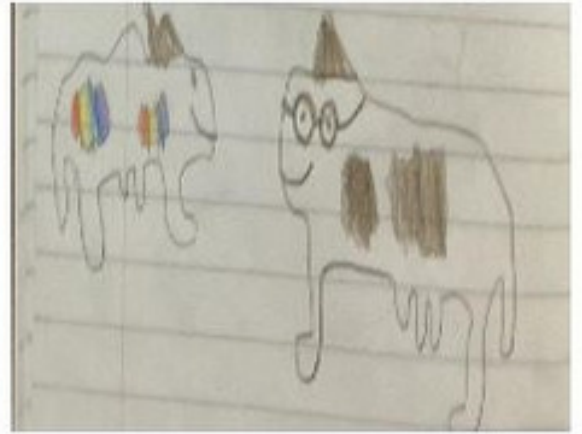
It didn't take long to arrive at the planet, because the magical cow was very fast.
