



Junior Coral Detective Floating Classroom

In collaboration with Marina at Keppel Bay, The Junior Coral Detective Programme kick started the International SeaKeepers Society Asia - Introduction to Marine Science and Conservation Asia Outreach Programme 2020.

Initiated by the Marina at Keppel Bay for their members' children to understand the importance of coral reefs, these Floating Classrooms took place on board Discovery Yacht The Admiral.

Facilitated by marine biologist Sam SQ, the 15 children who attended the session spent a fun morning as Junior Coral Detectives to learn about Singapore's marine environment and the basic biology of corals. They learnt about the major threats to coral reefs and discovered what marine conservation efforts were happening in Singapore.

The session's highlights were the hands-on practice and activities on coral restoration; coral bleaching simulation to demonstrate the effects of coral bleaching and the walkabout for coral observations within the Marina at Keppel Bay, which is home to a kaleidoscope of coral reef life.
