MyChart Video Visits for Patients

MyChart Video Visits allow you to have a virtual appointment with a provider using your smart phone or tablet through the MyUCSDHealth App.


- Recommend a minimum of iPhone 5 or above, iPad 3rd edition or above, Galaxy X5 or above
- Recommend a minimum of iOS: 12.0 or above, Android: 5.0 or above

Preparing for MyUCSDChart Video Visit

- 1. **Download** the MyUCSDHealth app on your mobile device. The free app is available in the Apple App Store for iphones or the Google Play Store for androids.

- 3. **Test** video connection works best with Wi-Fi or LTE speed:
 - Open MyUCSDHealth app.
 - Click MyUCSDChart icon.
 - **Log in** to your MyUCSDChart account. First time users, receive a MyChart activation code from the clinic. If you did not receive this code, please contact your provider's office.



- If you are accessing a proxy account, select the appropriate tab for the child
- Select Appointments icon.
- Select the video visit (grey video camera icon).
- Click TEST VIDEO icon (bottom of screen).



- 4. Complete eCheck-In at least 30 min prior to your scheduled visit or up to 7 days in advance:
 - Click the sime to complete all questionnaires and sign consents. Once completed, a sime will appear.




Starting MyUCSDChart Video Visit

TIPS:

- Have your **photo ID** nearby in case it is needed to verify your identity (at first visit).
- Be in a private setting where you can talk freely.
- Avoid distractions during the visit (doorbells, phones, children, pets, etc).
- Mute background noises like TV's and music.
- Try not to sit with a window or bright light behind you the best light comes from in front of you.
- 1. Connect to Wi-Fi for the best network connection. 4G or LTE will work but may result in interruptions.
- Open MyUCSDHealth app.
- 3. Click MyUCSDChart icon.
- 4. Log in to your MyUCSDChart account.
- 5. If you are accessing a **proxy account**, select the appropriate tab for the child.
- 6. Select Appointments icon.
- 7. Click on your video visit appointment.



8. Click the **BEGIN VISIT** icon (bottom of screen). It can take up to 20 seconds for the camera screen to be active.
