- October offered negative S&P500 results for the second month in a row as we approach election day
- We continued to see a rotation out of the high-flying technology stocks and into more industrial and economically sensitive areas of the market
- A stimulus package was never passed through Congress before the election, but clarity on the election results should result in more active stimulus talks
- Internationally, we have seen a spike in COVID-19 cases with some European countries imposing more restrictions as the fall weather approaches
- It is expected that the upcoming election results will take time to be finalized and market volatility could increase the longer it takes to receive final results
- Van Leeuwen & Company remains focused on the economic fundamentals to drive returns in the market and continues to focus on high quality companies with a history of weathering different economic cycles
