Do you have a phone bill? Then you are at risk! A recent IC3 alert was issued last month warning all telecommunication clients of a new scam on the rise.

Text, e-mail or phone call, ignore them all! No communications methods are safe from these sneaky scammers who contact unsuspecting clients and businesses claiming to be from the phone company or other telecommunication providers. Automated phone messages, SMS texts, and e-mails are being sent telling clients to visit a website to claim a reward.

These attacks are on the rise.

Beware, victims that have visited the site to claim a \$100 - \$2,500 prize or discount have been sadly deceived and their computers have been compromised.

What to look for? According to the Public Service Announcement by the IC3, these fraudulent websites may use words like MyBonus, ILike, ILove, Promo, Reward or similar words along with your telephone carriers name. If you receive a message like this, don't respond.


