Exporting Data from Sage100 to Excel (MAS90/200)

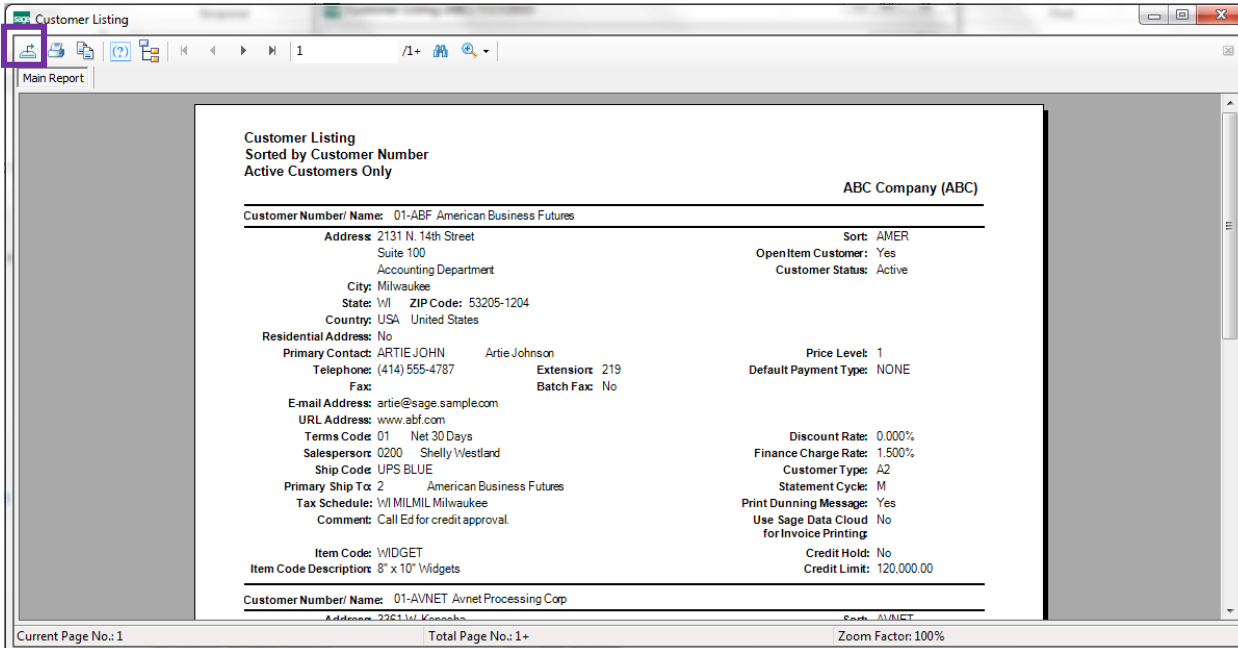

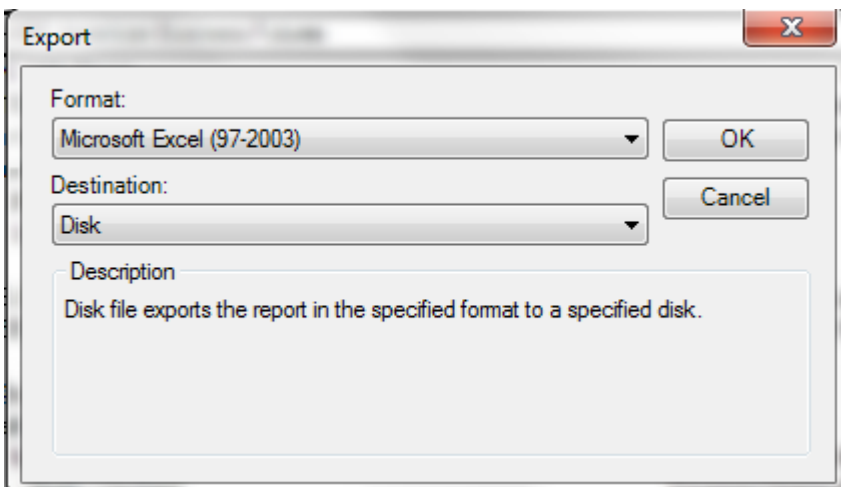

Almost every report in Sage100 is now Crystal Reports-based. Between reports and look-ups it is becoming easier to export data directly into Excel.

Any Crystal report can be exported to Excel. To export data from a Crystal Report directly to Excel, select a report and PREVIEW it. Once open click the first icon on the top right.



Using the drop-down listing, select Excel. If you want to easily edit immediately after exporting, select Application, Disk will save the file to your computer. You'll then be prompted to select some options related to exporting the data.



Once you've selected your options and click OK, Excel will open and the data from the report will be available to be edited or reformatted. Sometime the formatting from Crystal Reports is not exact when translating to Excel.

You might encounter some blank lines that you might not normally expect. This is due to the translation between Crystal and Excel, try "Excel – Data only" if this is the case.

You can export lookup list information from Sage 100 ERP to Excel as well. Whatever information is being shown in the view will be exported to Excel. Click on the Excel button at the bottom right.

Once the data is in Excel, it can be manipulated however the user sees fit.

The ability to export data makes it easy to extract data in the form of a report without having to spend hours creating custom reports to retrieve this information.
