This guide gives you a checklist of things to consider when evaluating IT services providers so you can find the one that best meets your needs and budget.

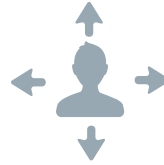


Goals & Objectives:

Are they where your business is? Where is the Service Desk located?

Do they operate under a proactive, continuous improvement model?



How quickly will they respond to support requests?



How easy is it for your users to engage with the supplier for support (i.e. email, phone call, chat, web portal)?



What is their first call resolution rate?



How will they guide you when you need strategic advice? What process do they have to do this?



Will they implement a technology roadmap to ensure your technology remains aligned to your key business drivers?

Technology & Policies:

Get peace of mind. Are they prepared for the worst and using state-of-the-art technology?



Is the supplier certified in all the major technologies you use?



Do they utilise and integrate leading toolsets for operational efficiency and reporting?



Do they continue to invest in certification?



Check out their disaster recovery and continuity plans.



What are their security, confidentiality and backup policies and procedures?



Are they technology agnostic, not tied to vendors with exclusive agreements?

Financial & Contractual:

Avoid nasty surprises. Read the fine print and look for hidden costs.



What is the ongoing management cost and how will you be charged (monthly, fixed fee, by the hour)?



How much variable cost will you be exposed to?
