

## IMPORTANT NOTICE

### Lane Reduction on Second Avenue Beginning on or around January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2012

In support of the Second Avenue Subway (SAS) project, MTA contractors will be **reducing Second Avenue to three traffic lanes (from four traffic lanes) from 101<sup>st</sup> Street to 99<sup>th</sup> Street**. This change will occur the week of January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2012. This lane reduction is necessary for preparation of slurry wall installation due to the size of the equipment being utilized.

There will be three lanes of traffic maintained at all times. Furthermore, NYPD Traffic Enforcement Agents will be placed at the intersections of Second Avenue and 101<sup>st</sup>, 100<sup>th</sup>, and 99<sup>th</sup> Streets. This lane reduction will be in place through the summer of 2012.

Please note the scope and nature of construction activities are subject to change based upon field conditions. All work has been approved by appropriate City agencies where required. We appreciate your patience during construction.
