DESCRIPTION

The Department of City Planning has submitted proposed revisions to the New York City Waterfront Revitalization Program (WRP) for consideration under the rules for the processing of plans pursuant to Charter Section 197-a. On March 26, 2012 the City Planning Commission determined that the above listed application meets the threshold standards for form, content, and consistency with sound planning policy required by the rules for processing 197-a plans. An environmental assessment of the application has been completed, with a determination that it would have no significant effect on the environment.

With completion of the threshold determination and environmental assessment, the proposed plan is now ready for review by affected community boards, Borough Presidents and borough boards in accordance with Article 6 of the rules. **The period for the Community Boards' review begins on April 3, 2012 and any comments or recommendations must be transmitted to the City Planning Commission by June 4, 2012.** The City Planning Commission will review the plan after the community and borough level review has been completed.
