Ed Koch Queensboro Bridge

The New York City Department of Transportation Division of Bridges will close one lane on the eastbound upper level of the Ed Koch Queensboro Bridge beginning on Monday, June 18th for the installation of 218 new LED necklace lights. Work will be performed between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and on weekends between 6:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. and is expected to be completed on or before Friday August 31st. To alert motorists of lane closures, a Variable Message Board will be stationed at the upper level entrance in Manhattan. Upon the completion of the conversion of the eastbound lighting, the program will continue on the westbound side.
