RECONSTRUCTION OF TRUNK WATER MAINS ALONG EAST 59TH STREET PROJECT # MED600

WATER SERVICE INTERRUPTION

SATURDAY, JULY 14, 2012 FROM 8:30 AM UNTIL 3:30 PM
AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATION:

- EAST 59TH STREET BETWEEN 2ND AVENUE AND 3RD AVENUE

WHY IS MY WATER BEING TURNED OFF?

In order for the existing water main to be replaced, the water must be shut off, old pipe withdrawn and new pipe installed. This work may be completed sooner and water will be turned back on at that time.

SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- DDC recommends that a qualified person shut off the water main “house” valve in your house/building in order to avoid sediment entering your building’s system, which is common with this type of operation.
- You are asked to shut off all WATER cooled appliances which may include air conditioners, etc.
- Once water service is restored, turn the main house valve back on and flush the system by running your faucets to sinks and tubs for a few minutes.
- Be sure that all faucets (kitchen, bathrooms, etc.) are in the off position during the water service interruption (this is to avoid water over flowing once the new water main is put into service).
- You may want to store water ahead of time in your sinks and/or bathtubs in order to flush toilets (not for drinking).
