FDR Drive Closures

For Installation of Replacement Bridge Span

One and Two Lane Closures

11:00 p.m. Saturday, October 15 to 2:00 a.m. Sunday, October 16, 2011

Followed by

Full Roadway Closure

Sunday, October 16, 2011, 2:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.

On Saturday October 15, beginning at 9:00 p.m., construction crews will mobilize to install the replacement pedestrian bridge over the FDR at E. 78th Street. At 11:00 p.m. and continuing overnight until 7:00 a.m. on Sunday October 16, the New York City Department of Transportation will implement **lane and road closures** of the Northbound and Southbound FDR to complete the installation of the bridge. The FDR will be completely re-opened to traffic at 7:00 a.m. on Sunday morning, October 16, 2011. During the closure period, Construction Signs, Variable Message Boards and Traffic Control Agents will guide motorists along the detour routes shown on the following page and as described below:

One & Two Lane Closures

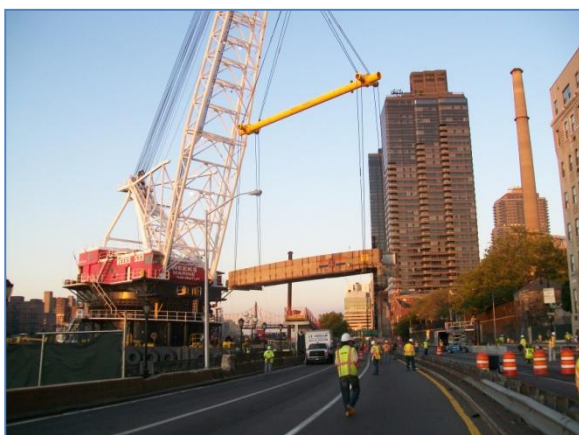
Closures will begin approximately one-half mile before the work area in the vicinity of E. 78th St. on both the northbound and southbound lanes and will include closure of the southbound FDR ramp at E. 79th St. and access to E. 78th St. between the FDR Drive and Cherokee Place.

Full Closure FDR Drive

**2:00 a.m. until 7:00 a.m.
Sun, October 16, 2011**

Downtown traffic on the Southbound FDR Drive will be directed along 2nd Avenue from **116th Street to E. 74th Street**, right onto **York Avenue to E. 73rd Street**, and back onto the southbound FDR Drive at E. 73rd Street, as shown on the map on the following page.

Uptown traffic on the Northbound Drive will be directed along 1st Avenue from **E. 61st Street to E. 96th Street** as shown on the attached page.



Old Bridge Span Removed on July 31

It is expected that all work on the bridge and adjacent ramps will be completed by early November, 2011.
