For more than 30 years, the United Federation of Teachers (UFT) and the New York City Department of Education (DOE) have teamed up in a joint project called Dial-A-Teacher. This service for elementary and middle school students puts parents and students in direct contact with experienced New York City teachers for help with challenging homework questions.
