



WEEKEND TRAFFIC ADVISORY
Friday, October 1, 2010 to Sunday, October 3, 2010

As part of its citywide traffic improvement program, the New York City Department of Transportation has compiled a list of areas where Street construction or Street events will impede the normal flow of traffic this weekend.

MANHATTAN

West 9th Street between 6th Avenue and 5th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 13th Street between 9th Avenue and Washington Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 6am to 1pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 19th Street between 9th Avenue and 8th Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 29th Street between 7th Avenue and 6th Avenue: This street will be closed Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 70th Street between 3rd Avenue and 2nd Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 77th Street between Park Avenue and Lexington Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 82nd Street between Lexington Avenue and 3rd Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 90th Street between 5th Avenue and Madison Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 93rd Street between Riverside Drive and West End Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

East 123rd Street between Park Avenue and Lexington Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

West 144th Street between Frederick Douglas Boulevard and Adam Clayton Powell Boulevard: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate crane operation.

Greene Street between Broome Street and Spring Street: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

Nassau Street between Ann Street and Fulton Street; Ann Street between Park Row and Williams Street; including intersection of Ann Street at Nassau Street: This street will be closed Saturday from 8am to 6pm and Sunday from 9am to 6pm to facilitate NYCDDC roadway work.

Church Street between Franklin Street and White Street: Two lanes on Church Street will be maintained Saturday from 8am to 6pm and Sunday from 9am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.

Gold Street between Fulton Street and Ryders Alley: This street will be closed Friday from 8am to 3pm to facilitate sewer inspection work.

Stone Street between Hanover Square and Coenties Alley; Mill Lane between Stone Street and South Williams Street: These streets will be closed daily from 10am to 11pm April 1 through November 30th for the Stone Street Pedestrian Mall as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

East End Avenue between East 84th Street and East 88th Street: This street will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the Carl Schurz Park Gracie Square Art Show as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

Formation: West 38th Street between 5th Avenue and Broadway
Route: 6th Avenue between West 38th Street and West 27th Street
Dispersal: West 27th Street between Broadway and 7th Avenue
The above streets will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the Korea Times Parade as permitted by NYPD.

Adam Clayton Powell Boulevard between West 115th Street and West 129th Street: This street will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the Harlem Children Society Parade as permitted by NYPD.

Lexington Avenue between East 57th Street and East 42nd Street: This street will be closed Saturday from 11am to 6pm for the Cathedral High School NYC October Festival as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

John Street between Front Street and Water Street; Water Street between Fletcher Street and Fulton Street; Front Street between John Street and Maiden Lane: These streets will be closed Sunday from 11am to 6pm for the Association of Indians in America Deepavali Festival as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

Broadway (West Side only) between West 110th Street and West 96th Streets: This street will be closed Sunday from 11am to 6pm for the Bloomingdale Area Coalition and One Stop Senior Services Street Festival as permitted by the Mayor's Street Activity Permit Office (SAPO).

Formation: 36th Street between Madison Avenue and 6th Avenue

Route: 5th Avenue between 56th Street and 36th Street

Dispersal: 53rd Street between 5th Avenue and 6th Avenue; 54th Street between 6th Avenue and Park Avenue

The above streets will be closed Sunday from 11am to 5pm or the General Pulaski Memorial Parade as permitted by NYPD.

BROOKLYN

Gowanus Expressway outbound/southbound exit to Prospect Expressway: This exit will be closed from 11pm Friday through 5am Saturday to facilitate NYSDOT construction activity. Motorists should use the prior Hamilton Avenue exit or the next 39th Street exit.

Grand Avenue between Atlantic Avenue and Lefferts Place: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 4pm to facilitate crane operation.

Junius Street between Blake Avenue and Sutter Avenue: This street will be closed Saturday and/or Sunday from 8am to 6pm to facilitate crane operation.
